### **What are the vaccines for coronavirus**

There is currently one coronavirus vaccine that is approved for use, and mass vaccination has already begun. This is GAM-Covid-Vec (or Sputnik V). No other vaccines are being used yet. Meanwhile, the development of new vaccines continues in the world, they do not stop for a minute. Until a few years ago, it took 15 to 20 years from virus analysis to vaccine approval. New technologies and previous experience with vaccines against related viruses are making significant acceleration possible. This is evidenced by reports from companies and research groups on the progress of the vaccine project. Two companies abroad have already applied for marketing authorizations, and many others are currently testing their vaccines in volunteers, some of them already participating in the final Phase III study. There are requirements for a vaccine against coronavirus, and they are defined. The ideal coronavirus vaccine will provide complete and lifelong protection against SARS-CoV-2 infection with few to mild side effects for anyone vaccinated with it. However, no vaccine is likely to fully achieve this ideal goal, although it may come as close as possible to it. For example, in the United States, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) first of all insists that vaccines against Covid-19 are safe and that this has been convincingly proven in large clinical trials. The FDA has announced that it will require an efficacy rate of at least 50%. This means that a larger group of vaccinated people will infect only half the number of people with the disease than a comparable group of unvaccinated people. In our country, the effectiveness of the Sputnik V vaccine is declared to be about 90%.
